Terms and conditions

By submitting an entry to The Mind Gym's Academic Prize 2008, the entrant agrees with the following:

- My submission is no longer than 8,000 words.
- Research for my submission has been carried out within the two years preceding 12th December 2008
- My submission is written in English.
- My submission contains an executive summary of no more than 500 words indicating the potential for application.
- If my research is short listed for the prize, I will endeavour to create an online presentation to share my work with the voting public.
- I will partake in interviews about my research and the practical applications of it, with our associates Psychologies magazine.
- The Mind Gym reserves the right to not award prizes if the Academic Board of judges does not feel the submissions are appropriate. The Mind Gym's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

For both published and unpublished submissions:

- I give permission for the ideas from my research to be used by The Mind Gym in future projects and product development including, but not limited to: books, workshop material, press and general marketing. I understand that if this is to occur, I, the author(s) will be fully referenced.
- It is my responsibility to ensure that there are no competing claims for intellectual property rights or copyright over my submitted research and to satisfy The Mind Gym that this is the case. For example, in books or television programmes.

For published work:

- Although my research paper itself is owned under copyright laws by the publisher of the journal, I consent to The Mind Gym using the ideas from my research in accordance with standard copyright laws.

For unpublished work:

- I consent to allowing The Mind Gym to use my research and freely reference from the paper. If my work is later submitted for publication, it is my responsibility to let the relevant publishing body know of its involvement in the prize. I will also notify The Mind Gym if this is the case.
